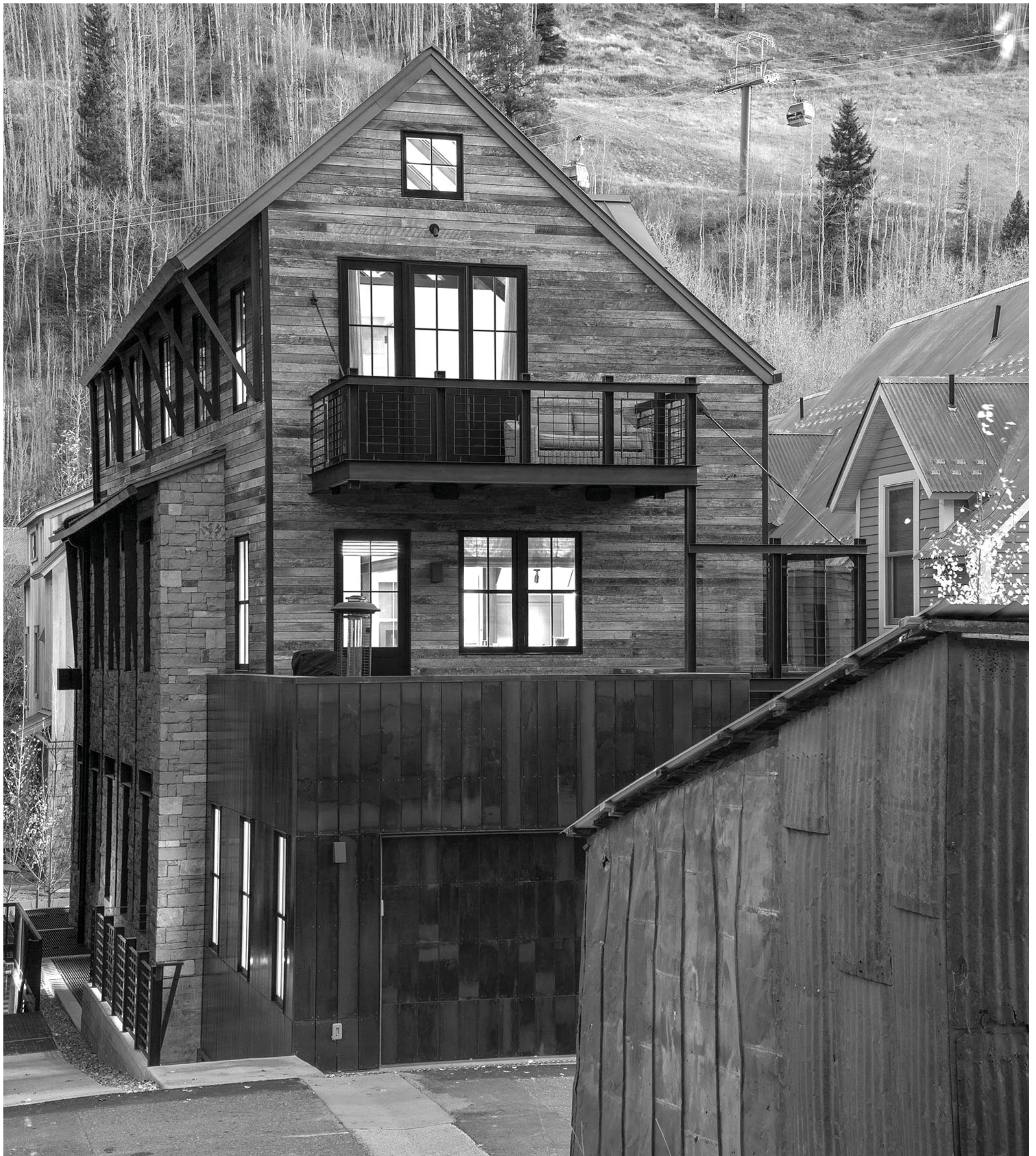
413 DEPOT

We were inspired by industrial architecture during the railroad period for the design of this 5,000 square foot, sustainable ski house for a family from Chicago.

We employed funky, elemental building forms imbued in stone, barnwood, and steel, that are indigenous to Telluride.

The slightly skewed walls recall historic building relationships to the grid, open the side-yards for more natural light, and contribute to the unique, eclectic character of this new structure.

This project recalls history, blends into its surroundings, and forges a bold vision for the future.
